We are looking into Class face book groups managed by parents to keep information current as possible. The grade 3s 2019 were very proactive in this and so if there are any class parents available to help set this up and manage, we would love to hear from you.

RAD Results: The studio was very pleased with the results with all graded children receiving strong marks this year. We gained a 39% Distinction rate with Lola Armstrong gaining near perfect scores for Advanced 1 and Grade 7, congratulations Lola. The Distinction mark is difficult to achieve these days so congratulations to students gaining this standard. Once you have learnt Classical Ballet you can dance any discipline to a high standard. The RAD work, which the children really love, does improve co-ordination, movement, memory, awareness of posture and body alignment and works well to develop a good sense of rhythm. All sounds wonderful but, in order to gain these skills, regular class attendance and practice at home are the keys to success in all genre. We are also trying to have more parental input to

help with practice at home so we are encouraging all parents to view once a month and or attend the once a term cushion concerts.

Classes: Adult Ballet has been scheduled again and Miss Jenny has provided a wonderful class for past ballet lovers to improve fitness. We have again timetabled the class after a number of requests, so parents and friends come and try it out, have fun and experience the joy of dancing.

Tiny Tots classes from 3 years are themed this year and should delight! Please recommend us to your friends, first class free Trial.

SLS classes are back on the high priority list as these conditioning classes are the key to maintaining strength and flexibility and improving technique. If taking 2 or more second subjects these classes are free. All students are highly recommended to take these classes. Jn = Gr 3-5, Int= Pre Ele, Ele Jazz and Snr= Int/Adv.

RAD Ballet classes. At Grade 5 level and above it is expected that students should attend 3 ballet lessons a week where possible. These can be their scheduled class and two or 3 of the next level up. ie Grade 5 and 2 Intermediate foundation classes, Advanced 1 and 2 students ideally 4 times a week.

Contemporary classes start from 10 years of age and is fabulous to enhance Ballet. The Ballerina's Yoga!

Fees: The Term fee for all classes has had to have a small increase this year, but with the discount applied you'll find very minimal difference, so please take advantage of this. Any Term fees paid by monthly or weekly instalments do not qualify for the discount and full Term fee applies. Any Term fees outstanding by week 6 will incur an admin fee this year of \$25.00. A \$15.00 discount is still available if paid during the first week of each new Term. Second subjects are already heavily discounted to \$50.00 per Term.
